NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

1. All cattle **MUST** be at Show grounds by 8.30am. **No exceptions**
2. Classes will refer to the following Breeds: Jersey, Australian Illawarra's, Friesian, Ayrshire, and Brown Swiss.
3. Cattle **NOT** to be removed before 3 pm (unless authorized by Chief Steward).
4. Age of cattle to be taken from 1 April, 2026.
5. Only cattle approved by the Herd Book Societies of each Breed will be accepted for entries. Animals entered in the fourth and fifth appendices in the Holstein-Friesian Stud Book are **NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE EXHIBITED**.
6. Any cow or heifer entered as dry, if freshened at time of competition shall compete as wet cow or heifer or vice versa, and it shall be the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor as early as possible to notify the Stewards.
7. No female under 3 years may compete for the Senior Championship. Second Prize animal to the Senior Champion is eligible to compete for Reserve Champion.
8. Animals under 3 may compete for Junior Champion.
9. Two or more persons shall not exhibit conjointly in any section unless they can prove to the Steward's satisfaction that they are bona fide partners trading as one firm or occupying the same farms, except in Sire and Progeny Classes.
10. All breeds are to be judged separately within their Classes except for Inter-Breed Classes.
11. The Feature Breed leads the Parade, but if no Feature Show, the Supreme Cow leads.
12. Cattle not thoroughly tractable will not be admitted to the Show grounds. All stock must be in the charge of the Exhibitor or his employee.
13. **All bulls 12 months and over must have nose rings. A leading staff or two leaders must be used for bulls 18 months and over.**
14. Prize money paid from Secretary Office after 2.00pm, please refer to rule 3 General Rules for Prizemoney allocation.

D.P.I. NOTICE

1. No cattle will be allowed entry to the Toogoolawah Show ground unless accompanied by a fully completed Movement Record or NVD Waybill as prescribed by the Biosecurity Act 2014.

JOHNE'S DISEASE – for Bovine Johne's Disease

It is your General Biosecurity Obligation as the exhibitor NOT to knowingly spread the disease. Any Cattle from suspected herds that have not yet been cleared by Biosecurity Queensland will not be accepted on to the showgrounds.

Rules:

- Each exhibitor has an obligation to take all reasonable and practical measures to prevent the introduction into, and spread of Johne's disease within, Queensland.
- Exhibitors must not enter animal(s) which are reasonably known or suspected of being infected with Johne's disease, including animals which have been introduced with a significant likelihood of being infected.
- Exhibitors must supply a health statement/declaration that provides information about the health of the animal including Johne's risk. The health statement/declaration must not be false, incomplete or misleading.

NOTE: All Competitors to pay Gate Admission Fee unless Members of Toogoolawah Show Society

Toogoolawah Showgrounds is **not** in the Fire Ant Zones.
Anyone bringing *hay, straw, chaff, silage or potted plants* from Queensland Fire Ant Zones to the Toogoolawah Showgrounds must comply with the [current](#) Queensland Fire ant movement requirements.
